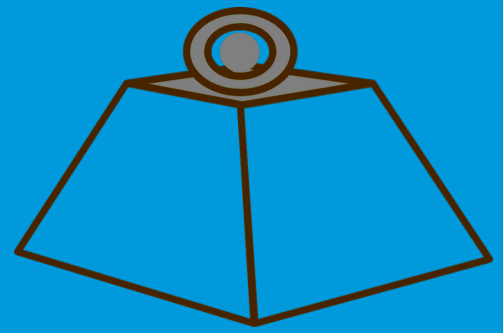


# WEEE RECYCLING @
